Each year DHET will award Amy Johnson Engineering Bursaries to individuals who are licensed or unlicensed aircraft engineers with an interest in the restoration and maintenance of vintage aircraft and who are aiming to further their professional experience and qualifications.

Selection Process

Following assessment of written applications, selected candidates will be called for interview, when they will have the opportunity of explaining to the Panel how they would use the funds in the furtherance of their vintage aircraft interests. As a result of this interview, bursary awards will be made, subject to confirmation by the Board of Trustees.
